**Your visit to us**

We can't wait to welcome you to Paultons Park on your school trip soon. Paultons Park is a theme park with lots of rides, gardens and animals. You'll be with your teachers and friends all day – but you might see some of our staff around the Park. All of our staff wear uniforms and they will always be happy to help you.



When you arrive at the Park, you might go to our coach park. Our coach park is near the entrance and your teachers will ask you to leave the coach and wait on the pavement.



It is important that you listen to your adults as there might be other coaches trying to Park and other cars around. Make sure you keep to the path as you head to the Park.

This is our entrance area. It is where all of our visitors enter the Park. Your teacher might have to collect tickets but once they have tickets, they will give you a ticket so you can get into the Park.





This is one of our friendly gate team. It is their job to scan your ticket and let you into the Park. Once your ticket has been scanned, you will need to push on a special barrier to get into the Park. Your teachers will need to do this as well!

Once inside the Park, you will go through our Gateway Building and see our floating globe. It is very special to us and weighs over 6 tonnes!



Lots of schools start their visit by going to the toilets. We have lots of toilets around the Park.

Our toilets are cleaned by our cleaning team regularly. In fact, we won a national award for having the cleanest toilets in the UK!!




You might have an exciting workshop booked. Most of the workshops take place in Professor Blast's Learning Lab. Professor Blast conducts lots of funny science experiments in his Lab and he lets our Education Team use the room for school groups.

You won't meet Professor Blast, but you will meet a member of our Education Team who will run your workshop.

The room is up a set of steps and the entrance is a little bit dark – but there are coloured lights and bubbling test tubes to help you find your way. Once in the Lab, Paultons Park staff will run your session. There are lots of things to see in the Lab.



We hope you won't need to, but if you feel poorly or have an accident, you might need to visit our First Aid Team. Our nurses look after everyone who visits the Park.



Our First Aid Nurses will also help you if you get lost. They will help you find your teachers and friends again. Not many school children get lost in our theme park though because the teachers look after the children really well!



We have lots of things for you to do at Paultons Park including rides. Some rides are fast, some are gentle so there is something for everyone.

Sometimes, our staff will need to check your seat belt, to make you sure everyone is safe before the ride starts.
